We have been helping produce aluminium in Australia for 60 years. Our two bauxite mines and three alumina refineries in Western Australia produce about 50% of Australia's alumina and our Portland Aluminium Smelter* in Victoria produces more than 20% of the nation's aluminium.

Our alumina refineries are among the lowest CO₂ emitting refineries in the world and we are leaders in mine site rehabilitation.

We employ thousands of people, predominantly in the local communities near where we operate, and strive to create value for all stakeholders.
