Operations

- Lake Charles Carbon Company operates a deep-water port facility for discharging and loading barges
 and ocean-going vessels. The plant brings in green petroleum coke from various domestic and foreign
 suppliers to create calcined coke for internal customers.
- The various cokes are blended using heavy equipment to meet customer specifications and processed through a rotary calciner. The calciner is permitted for up to 52 short wet tons of feed, heating the coke up to 2500 F to remove water, volatiles and change the crystalline structure of the coke.
- The coke is then quenched with well water and stored in silos for bulk shipments to Canada, Norway, Brazil, and Australia.

Economic Impact

- The Lake Charles Operations has a talented and diverse team of 48 employees, including one labor union The United Steelworkers Local 13-555.
- Our plant owns 216.25 acres (Reynolds Metals In.) and leases 80 acres from the Port of Lake Charles.
- In 2024, Alcoa's combined US sites injected approximately \$345 million into the local communities through direct salaries, wages and benefits and \$619 million was invested with some 1800 US suppliers.
 - Lake Charles' contribution was approximately \$7.5 million in direct salaries, wages and benefits and \$32 million in US supply contracts.
- Alcoa's US operations combined injected \$2.6 million into the country's income taxes.

- Lake Charles takes the rejected material from the oil refining process and turns it into a product that is consumed in the smelting process of making primary aluminium.
- Lake Charles is currently pursuing using heat generated in process to purify other waste steams
 for product sales to third party manufacturers. The heat is also being considered for generating
 what is considered green energy.
